Uniform Policy

We are very proud of our exceptionally high standards regarding uniform and expect all students to be dressed correctly at all times. This document explains what our expectations are and what action will be taken if incorrect uniform is worn in school.

If students are missing any items of uniform, parents/carers will be contacted. We endeavour to support students with their uniform. However, students who continually choose not to follow the expectations will be sanctioned.

Parents/carers will be informed if a student does not attend breaktime sanction and the student will be required to stay after school for a phase 2 sanction.

Inappropriate items will be confiscated and can be collected at the end of the school day. If the same item is confiscated for a second day, parents/carers will be expected to collect the items.

All uniform and PE kit is available from The School Shop, 14 Prospect Hill, Kidderminster DY10 1PA.

Please contact the school if you have any issues relating to uniform due to religious reasons.

No hoodies/designer jackets are to be worn. ALL outdoor clothing including scarves must be removed in once inside the school building.

PLEASE mark all items of uniform with the student's name.



Jumpers

Plain, black, normal school style v neck jumpers can be worn under blazers. No cardigans.



Accessories

Electrical devices including mobile phones, ear phones and iPods are allowed in school but should only be used outside, in the Hub and not be seen or used during lesson time unless permission is given by the teacher



All items of this nature are brought in to school at students' own risk.

School Bag and Equipment

Students should bring the following equipment to school every day:

- A school bag of suitable size to carry books, homework, PE kit etc. NO handbags.
- Pens, pencils, ruler and eraser.
- A school planner, provided by the school.



Jewellery/Piercings/Tattoos/Nails

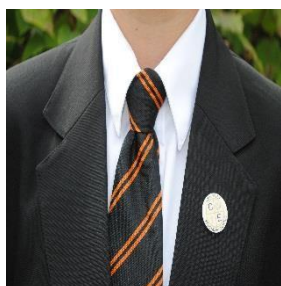
Only one plain stud in each ear and a wrist watch may be worn. Other piercings are not permitted in school. Please ensure that if your son/daughter choses to have piercings, that they are done during holidays so that they can be removed BEFORE they return to school. Covering of these is NOT accepted.
Tattoos are not allowed.
Nails should be natural in colour and of moderate length.

Hair

Inappropriate hair styles are NOT allowed. This includes hair with shaved patterns/lines/tracks, skinheads or shaved lower than a grade 2. Hair should be natural in colour.
If the policy is not followed, students may be put into isolation until the hairstyle is rectified.

Ties

All year 7 to 11 students must wear clip on ties.



Blazers

All years – plain black blazer

Footwear

Footwear must be plain black and polishable, not canvas. Sports trainers, even black ones, are not allowed.



UNIFORM POLICY BOYS

| Shirt | Plain white shirt with buttons to collar suitable for a tie. Shirt tucked neatly into trousers. |
| Trousers | Black normal school style. Belts must be narrow and plain black. |
| Socks | Plain dark socks. |

UNIFORM POLICY GIRLS

| Shirt | Plain white shirt with buttons to collar (not a blouse) suitable for a tie. Shirt tucked neatly into skirt/trousers. |
| Trousers | Black normal school style (not fashion or tight fitting), no embellishments or attached fashion buckles. Belts must be narrow and plain black. |
| Skirts | Black, school (non fashion) skirt that is of a reasonable length (just on or above the knee). The skirt must not be figure hugging "tube" or of a jersey/lycra material that is prone to "riding up". Instead, skirts should be of a material and style that allows it to hang to its full length. |
| Socks | Plain dark socks or suitable tights. Tights must be grey, fawn, black or neutral. |

All Students

All students must have the following PE Kit available from The School Shop in Kidderminster:

- White polo shirt with school badge □ Black shorts with school badge.
- Plain white sports socks or WCESS socks (black/gold).
- Trainers or pumps.



Optional Items:

- Black tracksuit bottoms
- Reversible rugby shirt (black/gold).
- Black Wolverley fleece.
- Plain black waterproof coat for bad weather.
- Black hat and gloves for cold weather (dependent on the sport).
